WORSHIP RENEWAL

At Antioch, we are at the brink of something awesome. A new and exciting season is upon us! As this fellowship of Christian believers approaches the completion and dedication of a new worship facility, we must also anticipate the voice of the One who has not only brought us to this place, but will continue to lead us until the day that His work is complete and His will is made perfect in us. It is still His work and His will, which must be done His way.

It is equally important for us to realize that brick and mortar does not facilitate worship in and of itself. While the new sanctuary stands as a glorious monument and will provide a space where we come to honor God together, worship begins in the hearts, minds, and attitudes of those who will enter. While our new facility will almost certainly provide a place of refreshing, it is important that our worship also be renewed. We might have forgotten how to worship, so we want to ensure that the inner sense of God's Spirit—the communion between the Creator and the created—be made real to us all over again.

What Is Worship Renewal?

Worship renewal should be part of our congregation's efforts to revitalize and redevelop itself into a future that only God can imagine, but it cannot be reduced to a formula or generated by a set of techniques. Neither can it be manufactured by the style of songs we sing or the order in which our Sunday worship flows. Worship renewal is not something that human ingenuity or creativity can produce or engineer; rather, it is a gift of God's Spirit. Renewal is a gift for which we pray rather than an accomplishment we achieve.

Today, in churches around the world, people gather for worship. But as people enter sanctuaries of worship, large and small, they know less and less about church—our history, stories, rituals

and language, songs, and Scriptures. Many worship services are attended by people who have no loyalty to what we do or why we do it. Instead, they are looking for something that has meaning in the here and now.

If Antioch is to be a church for all people, developing relationships with God and man in every time and place, we must have the courage, find the time, and trust the Spirit enough to allow our worship to be made new, even in the midst of being the church.

Why Is Worship Renewal Needed?

Our worship needs renewal because our church services tend to be human-centered. The Bible tells us that worship is not primarily for the people, but for God. Worship was intentionally designed to recognize His glory and to exalt His name. But the current approach to worship has created an atmosphere in which many people come to church expecting to be entertained.

The general trend toward adapting secular culture and practices has diminished the differences between the Christian community and the world. Worship and preaching, which should stand at the heart of the Sunday experience, is now, in some regards, unable to shape, challenge, inspire, enhance, motivate, nourish, and feed as it is intended to do.

Our churches must refocus on the importance of all things being done for God's glory. When genuine worship takes place, the entire congregation is not only edified and built up, but the mission and the outreach of the church is strengthened. Once the people of God have been strengthened, we are then prepared to enter the world and touch lives; meet needs; heal hurts; speak to injustices; and, most of all, witness and proclaim the saving message of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

ANTIOCH CARES

The Great Commission of Matthew 28:19-20 reminds us to “go ye therefore” and make a difference in the lives of those who may be the least, the lost, the last and the left-out.

Intercessory Prayer – Valerie Bryant-Ward, Lead Servant South Campus; Tonika Johnson, Lead Servant North Campus. Every Sunday morning and throughout the week at both campuses, the Intercessory Prayer Ministry's responsibility is to invoke the Spirit of God to inhabit His Temple; to invite His presence to do marvelous works and to intercede on behalf of others that their needs be met, and that God gets the glory.

Street Ministry – Lisa Williams, Lead Servant South Campus; James Duke, Lead Servant North Campus. The Street Ministry is charged with going out into the community every Saturday to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ. As we work in the streets, the Holy Spirit works in the spirit realm to draw those that He has chosen. That is why we do not worry about what we are going to say or do for the Holy Spirit brings back to our remembrance what we have studied and prayed for that the person chosen will hear what God ordains for him to hear.

Feeding & Clothing Ministry – Marly Walters, Lead Servant South Campus. One of our largest ministries at Antioch is the Feeding & Clothing Ministry. Every third Saturday, this ministry provides food and clothing for our community at-large. This ministry gives God glory by being obedient to his word: “For I was an hungred, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in: Naked, and ye clothed me...”

Missions Ministry – Martha Toomer, Lead Servant South Campus; LaJane Ward, North Campus. The Missions Ministry is a two-pronged ministry serving both international and local constituents. In the international setting, we sponsor an

orphanage headed by Pastor Lucien Almanord of Ambassadors of Jesus Children's Home in Port Au Prince, Haiti as well as a group of fifty or more other churches and pastors. Our local arm of the ministry assists families in distress, in addition to feeding and clothing the homeless. In June, we will partner with Showering Love to provide a 44-foot RV to offer showers for the homeless community.

Prison Ministry – Elder Demetrius Chaney, Lead Servant South Campus. The Prison Ministry is engaged in ministering to inmates at the Everglades Correctional Institute and the Women's Work Release Facility. Our ministry to the incarcerated includes preaching and teaching the word of God. It is a glorifying feeling of satisfaction that one gets from going behind prison walls to convey the message of Christ and observing the response.



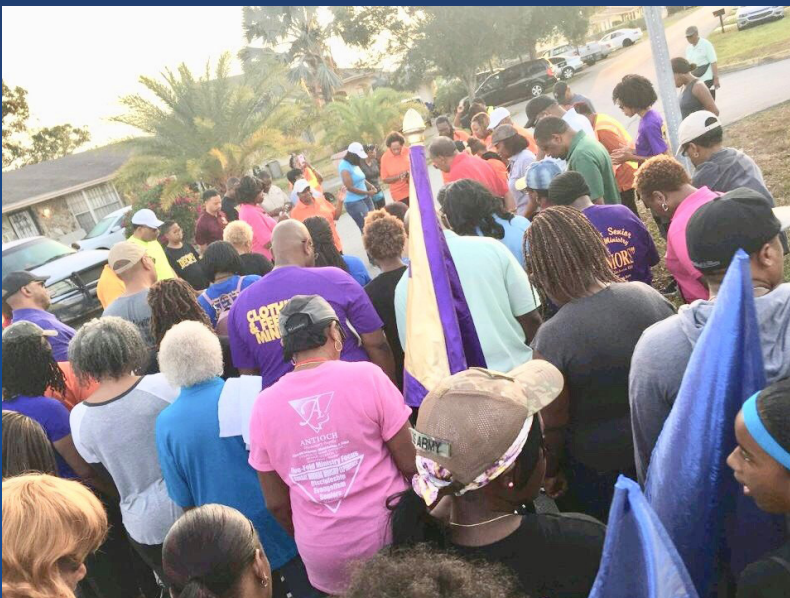


Nursing Home Ministry – Doris Thomas, Lead Servant South Campus. The Nursing Home Ministry is a vital part of our evangelistic efforts at Antioch. Every first Saturday of the month, a contingency of our congregation goes to the Colonial Assisted Living Facility to deliver the word of God.

Social Justice Ministry – Deacon Michael McBride, Lead Servant South Campus. The Social Justice Ministry is highly engaged in impacting our community through voter registration, and other social justice issues throughout South Florida.

Visitation Ministry – Barbara Howard, Lead Servant South Campus. Dedicated to making home visits to the sick and shut-in, Sis. Howard and her team make sure those who may not be able to leave their place of residence continue to be connected to our ministry.

Bereavement Ministry – Carolyn Bowens, Lead Servant South Campus. The Bereavement Ministry reaches out to members who have lost loved ones and desire support from the church.

Just Cruisin'

I'd like to tell you about an exciting trip to scenic ports of call, so let's cruise!

A successful cruise requires several components: a vessel (usually a ship), points of interest, and passengers. The Book of Exodus records the first "transoceanic" crossing (the Red Sea), which involved a multitude of people, but no ship. The Bible makes several references to another "transoceanic" crossing (the Jordan River); but, again, the people who made the trip didn't do so in a luxury liner. In Mark 4, Jesus and the disciples needed to "cross over to the other side." In this account, they used a couple of ships, but then a storm interrupted their crossing.

The cruise that I am proposing is unique. You can board at any time, the cruise won't cost you anything, and the ship only makes two stops; but you will experience and enjoy lots of exciting things! Our ship doesn't travel on water—but don't worry, it's a legitimate ship, I promise. And like most cruises, you will get to know your fellow passengers because you will be engaging in group activities provided for you as you sail. Ready to board?

WELCOME ABOARD "THE DISCIPLE-SHIP"!

This ship is a special vessel where you can follow the teachings of God's Word and then put those teachings into practice. Our first port of call is Antioch South, which consists of three regions broken down into ten points of interest and headed by competent, experienced, and dedicated tour guides. The first stop is the People Region: the Men's Ministry, hosted by Deacon Ed Ponder; the Women's Ministry, hosted by Zina McNeal-Jackson; the Singles Ministry, co-hosted by Min. Faith Brown and David Thomas; and

the Couples Ministry, co-hosted by Ronald and Angela Mumford. Everyone can take advantage of at least two of these four points of interest.

Next is the Education Region, where you can develop your following of God's Word: the Sunday School Ministry, co-hosted by Deacon Derrick Glymph and Edward Duffie; the New Disciples Ministry, hosted by Deacon Robert Merrick; and the Teachers Ministry, hosted by yours truly. Each of these points of interest will build your spiritual infrastructure.

Do you want to further enhance yourself? Stop by the Enrichment Region: the Fitness Ministry, hosted by Carl Britton, and the Adoption Ministry, hosted by Ronald Mumford.

Our second port of call is Antioch North, consisting of two regions, with six points of interest.
